AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE BOSTON MUNICIPAL COURT.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave
3 bank for a certain employee of the Boston Municipal Court,
4 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law,
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, the Boston Municipal Court
3 is hereby authorized and directed to establish a sick leave bank
4 for Probation Officer Daniel Griffin. Any employee of the District
5 Court Department of the Trial Court of the Commonwealth may
6 voluntarily contribute one or more of his sick, personal or
7 vacation days for use by Daniel Griffin.
