AN ACT AUTHORIZING MEMBERS OF SCHOOL COMMITTEES TO ESTABLISH
CREDIT FOR SUCH SERVICES FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (o) of subdivision (1) of section 4 of Chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by striking line 181 and inserting in place thereof
4 the following: —

5 (o) Any member who served as a selectman, alderman, school
