AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF YARMOUTH TO APPROPRIATE A CERTAIN OVERLAY DEFICIT OVER A PERIOD OF YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or  
2 special law to the contrary, the town of Yarmouth is hereby  
3 authorized to carry its overlay deficit, as it existed as of June  
4 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and ninety-two and to raise in its tax  
5 rate said overlay deficit on the following ratio: one-fifth of said  
6 deficit in fiscal nineteen hundred and ninety-three, one-fifth of  
7 said deficit in fiscal nineteen hundred and ninety-four, one-fifth  
8 of said deficit in fiscal nineteen hundred and ninety-five, one-fifth  
9 of said deficit in fiscal nineteen hundred and ninety-six and the  
10 remaining one-fifth of said deficit in nineteen hundred and ninety-  
11 seven, or such other amount with the prior written approval of  
12 the director of accounts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
