The committee on Local Affairs, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1472) of Charles E. Shannon, Michael E. Capuano, Vincent P. Ciampa, Peter A. Vellucci and Patricia D. Jehlen for legislation to extend the time by which the budget must be submitted in cities, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 5458) of Robert T. Markel (mayor) and Anthony M. Scibelli (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to extend the time within which the mayor of the city of Springfield shall submit the annual budget for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and ninety-three, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5829) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Local Affairs be authorized
2 to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study of the current Senate document
4 numbered 1472 and current House document numbered 5458,
5 relative to the submission of the annual city budget by the mayor
6 to the city council and cities' authority to operate under a one-
7 twelfth budget.

8 Said committee shall report the results of its investigation and
9 study and its recommendations, if any, to the General Court,
10 together with the draft of legislation necessary to carry such
11 recommendations in'o effect by filing the same with the Clerk of
12 the House of Representatives or the Clerk of the Senate on or
13 before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and
14 ninety-two.
