**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE TO CONVEY A CERTAIN
PARCEL LAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the town of Barnstable is hereby authorized to
3 convey a certain parcel of conservation land located in said town.
4 Said parcel is described in a deed of William P. Swift to said town,
5 dated February 4, 1969, and recorded with the Barnstable registry
6 of deeds in Book 1430, Page 679 and three hundred and seventy-
7 five thousand dollars. Said parcel and money are to be conveyed
8 by said town in exchange for a parcel of land to be conveyed to
9 it by Recoll Management Corporation, consisting of the land in
10 said town of Barnstable, owned now or formerly, all or in part
11 by Albert R. Schofield, Jr., trustee of Hathaways Pond Nominee
12 Trust under a declaration of trust dated November 14, 1986, and
13 recorded with the Barnstable county registry of deeds in
14 Book 5408, page 164, consisting of 37.5 acres, more or less.
