2 to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study of current House document
4 number 5814, relative to the Middleborough Historical
5 Commission.

6 Said committee shall report the results of its investigation and
7 study and its recommendations, if any, to the General Court,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
9 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk
10 of the House of Representatives or Clerk of the Senate on or
11 before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and
12 ninety-two.
