AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OPERATION OF THE GAME OF BEANO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 38 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 134 by
3 inserting after the word, "games.", the following new sentence: —
4 An active member shall be allowed to invite no more than two
5 guests, who must be sixty years old or older, to participate in said
6 organization's beano games.
