To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

In order to accelerate further the economic development and growth of the Commonwealth, I am filing with you today "An Act Providing For Certain Tourism Activities". In light of the spectacular success of "Sail Boston", I am particularly proud to support additional tourism programs. Specifically, I am recommending supplemental appropriations for three line items as follows:

- o The Massachusetts Office of Travel and Tourism: \$3,295,000
- o Local Tourism Councils: \$1,730,000
- o The Massachusetts International Trade Council: \$242,000

By doing so, this Administration is demonstrating in practical terms its commitment to job creation and support of the business community -- whose success is inextricably linked with that of the Commonwealth's.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN TOURISM ACTIVITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in
 2 the general appropriation act, and for certain other activities and
 3 projects, the sums set forth in section two are hereby appropriated
 4 from the Massachusetts Tourism Fund, for the several purposes
 5 and subject to the conditions specified therein, subject to the
 6 provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and
 7 the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter one
 8 hundred and thirty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and
 9 ninety-two, for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen
 10 hundred and ninety-three or for such period as may be specified,
 11 the sums so appropriated to be in addition, unless otherwise
 12 specified, to any amounts available for the purposes.
