

By Mr. Palumbo of Newbury, petition of Thomas G. Palumbo and Robert C. Buell (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the board of selectmen of the town of Groveland to appoint the town treasurer. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TOWN TREASURER IN THE TOWN OF GROVELAND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of  
2 chapter forty-one of the General Laws or any other general or  
3 special law or by-law to the contrary, the treasurer of the town  
4 of Groveland shall be appointed by the board of selectmen of said  
5 town and the person so appointed shall have all the powers and  
6 duties by law vested in the office of treasurer.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of the  
2 town of Groveland for acceptance at a town election to be held  
3 on a date to be determined by the board of selectmen of said town  
4 in the form of the following question, which shall be placed on  
5 the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers at  
6 said election: —

7 “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen  
8 hundred and ninety-two, entitled ‘An Act providing for the  
9 appointment of the town treasurer in the town of Groveland’, be  
10 accepted?”. If the majority of the votes cast in answer to this  
11 question is in the affirmative, this act shall become effective, but  
12 not otherwise.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
