4 numbered 5521, relative to the establishment of a senior center

7 study and its recommendation, if any, to the General Court,
8 together with the draft of legislation necessary to carry such
9 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of
10 the House of Representatives or the Clerk of the Senate on or
11 before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and
12 ninety-two.
