1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Local Affairs be authorized
2 to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study of current House document
4 numbered 6027, relative to institutional master planning in the
5 city of Salem, and House document numbered 6069, relative to
6 water and sewer rates in the city of Boston.

7 Said committee shall report the results of its investigation and
8 study and its recommendation, if any, to the General Court,
9 together with the draft of legislation necessary to carry such
10 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of
11 the House of Representatives or the Clerk of the Senate on or
12 before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and
13 ninety-two.
