AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SEPARATION OF PRISONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-two of chapter one hundred and
2 twenty-seven of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section 29 of chapter 268 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in lines 10 to 13, inclusive, the words “, or who places
4 or keeps together prisoners in his custody of different sexes or
5 classes, contrary to section twenty-two of chapter one hundred
6 and twenty-seven,”.
