AN ACT REMOVING THE CITY OF NORTH ADAMS AS A MEMBER OF THE
NORTHERN BERKSHIRE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 135 of the Acts of 1988, as amended by
2 Chapter 457 of the Acts of 1991, is hereby further amended by
3 deleting from the third paragraph of Section 1 the words “the City
4 of North Adams” and “or by vote of the City Council in the case
5 of North Adams”.

1 SECTION 2. Sub-paragraph “f” of Section 1 of said Chap-
2 ter 135 is hereby amended by deleting the words “city or”.

1 SECTION 3. Sub-paragraph “h” of Section 1 of said Chap-
2 ter 135 is hereby amended by deleting the words “city council or”.

1 SECTION 4. Sub-paragraph “o” of Section 1 of said Chap-
2 ter 135 is hereby amended by deleting the words “city council or”.

1 SECTION 5. The third paragraph of Section 2 of said
2 Chapter 135 is hereby amended by deleting the words “the mayor
3 of any city in said district shall likewise be a representative or may
4 appoint a designee”.

1 SECTION 6. The first paragraph of Section 4 of said
2 Chapter 135 is hereby amended by deleting the words “or of the
3 city council” and “city or”.

1 SECTION 7. Section 5 of said Chapter 135 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the third sentence.

1 SECTION 8. This Act shall become effective upon passage.
