AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LIABILITY OF CERTAIN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 85K of Chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing
