AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately establish a sick leave
3 bank for certain employees of the commonwealth, therefore it is
4 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the department of
3 education is hereby authorized and directed to establish a sick
4 leave bank for Lawrence Witty, an employee of said department.
5 Each employee of the department of education may voluntarily
6 contribute one or more of his sick, personal or vacation days to
7 said sick leave bank for use by Lawrence Witty.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the department of
3 revenue is hereby authorized and directed to establish a sick leave
4 bank for Joan Wolfgang, an employee of said department. Each
5 employee of the department of revenue may voluntarily contribute
6 one or more of his sick, personal or vacation days to said sick
7 leave bank for use by Joan Wolfgang.
