The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF LEICESTER ACADEMY TO LEICESTER JUNIOR COLLEGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The name of Leicester academy, incorporated
2 by an act of the general court, passed on March twenty-third,
3 seventeen hundred and eighty-four, is hereby changed to
4 Leicester Junior College.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
2 by a majority of the trustees in office, on behalf of said corpora-
3 tion, and the filing in the office of the state secretary of a copy
4 of the vote of acceptance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That

do hereby enact the following laws:

SECTION 1. The name of the State of Massachusetts shall be changed to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
