HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, July 28, 1966.

The committee on Ways and Means, to whom were referred the Bill authorizing and directing the Department of Public Works to construct an overpass or an underpass across the Fourth Street ramp in the city of Chelsea (House, No. 1751); the Bill to construct an entrance ramp on Route 28 in Andover to north bound lanes of Route 495 (House, No. 1941); the Bill relative to the transportation or dumping of dredge materials in tide waters (House, No. 2437); the Bill authorizing and directing the Division of Waterways to dredge the Monatiquot River in the town of Braintree (House, No. 2438); the Resolve providing for an investigation and study by the Department of Public Works relative to directing said department to construct an access road between Route No. 28 in the town of West Bridgewater and the junction of interstate Routes No. 495 and No. 95 in the town of Mansfield (House, No. 3615); the Bill authorizing the Department of Public Works to reconstruct a railroad bridge in the city of Gardner (House, No. 3780); the Bill relative to establishing the harbor in the city of Lynn as a harbor of refuge by the Division of Waterways of the Department of Public Works (House, No. 3810); the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1604) of Warren A. Turner for legislation relative to state care and maintenance of public highway bridges over railroads; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2114) of Thomas M. Newth, Samuel E. Zoll, Michael J. Harrington, J. Hilary Rockett and Kevin B. Harrington that the Department of Public Works be directed to construct a trunk highway from Route 95 in Lynn or Peabody to the towns of Swampscott and Marblehead and the city of Salem report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 3915).

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO STATE CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY BRIDGES OVER RAILROADS AND CERTAIN OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to make an investigation of the subject
3 matter of current house documents numbered 1604, relative to
4 the care and maintenance of public highway bridges over rail-
5 roads; 1751, authorizing and directing the department of public
6 works to construct an overpass or an underpass across the Fourth
7 Street ramp in the city of Chelsea; 1941, to construct an en-
8 trance ramp on Route 28 in Andover to north bound lanes of
9 Route 495; 2114, authorizing the department of public works to
10 construct a trunk highway from Route 95 in the city of Lynn or
11 Peabody to vicinity of Vinian Square at the junction of the
12 towns of Swampscott and Marblehead and the city of Salem;
13 2437, relative to the transportation or dumping of dredge ma-
14 terials in tide waters; 2438, authorizing and directing the divi-
15 sion of waterways to dredge the Monaquot River in the town
16 of Braintree; 3615, providing for an investigation and study by
17 the department of public works relative to directing said de-
18 partment to construct an access road between Route No. 28 in
19 the town of West Bridgewater and the junction of Interstate
20 Routes No. 495 and No. 95 in the town of Mansfield; 3870,
21 authorizing the department of public works to reconstruct a
22 railroad bridge in the city of Worcester; 3810, relative to the
23 establishing the harbor in the city of Lynn as a Harbor of refuge
24 by the division of waterways of the department of public works.
25 Said department shall report to the general court the results of
26 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
27 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
28 mendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the
29 house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
30 December of the current year.
