AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CLASSIFICATION OF CAREER EMPLOYEES IN
THE DEPARTMENT OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 3 of chapter 14 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 460 of the acts of 1964,
3 is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the fifth
4 paragraph thereof the following sentence: — Any person ap-
5 pointed to such a supervisory position who previous thereto
6 had permanent status in the department in offices or positions
7 classified under chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, includ-
8 ing any promotion or reallocation for a total period of five years,
9 shall not be involuntarily separated therefrom except subject
10 to and in accordance with the provisions of sections forty-three
11 and forty-five of chapter thirty-one to the same extent as if
12 said office or position were classified under said chapter.
