RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED MERGER OF THE NATIONAL GUARD AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY RESERVE ON THE MEMBERS OF THESE UNITS, AND AUTHORIZING A SYSTEM OF CHARGES AT SOLDIERS' HOMES.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission, established by chap-
2 ter eighty-three of the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-
3 five and most recently revived and continued by chapter forty-
4 six of the resolves of the current year, shall, in the course of
5 its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of
6 current house document numbered 3816, further defining the
7 word "veteran".
