AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF KENNETH R. BOUDAH,  
A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON,  
AS A JUNIOR BUILDING CUSTODIAN IN THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT  
OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of section eight  
2 of chapter thirty-nine of the General Laws or any provision of  
3 the charter of the city of Northampton, Kenneth R. Boudah, of  
4 said city, may be appointed to the school department of said  
5 city as a junior building custodian; provided, that such ap-  
6 pointment is made in accordance with the civil service law  
7 and rules and, that he resigns as a member of the city council  
8 of said city.
