AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE PERSON HEADING A CIVIL SERVICE ELIGIBLE LIST AND WILLING TO ACCEPT BE APPOINTED TO THE POSITION FOR WHICH SUCH LIST WAS ESTABLISHED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 1964, is hereby further amended by inserting after the first
4 sentence the following sentence: — Notwithstanding any rule
5 made under this chapter, such appointing authority shall ap-
6 point the person who is number one on such list, or if such
7 person is not willing to accept such appointment, the person
8 next on said list who is so willing.
