AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO ASSUME THE COST
OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 35 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out sections 30 and 31 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section: —

4 *Section 30.* The commonwealth shall assume the entire cost
5 of the operation of the several counties, including the payment
6 of county debt and interest charges, and no county taxes shall
7 be levied on the cities and towns of the commonwealth.
