By Mr. Conte, a petition of John J. Conte that provision be made for reimbursement by the county of Worcester to the city of Worcester for the time spent by police officers of said city while attending as witnesses in certain courts. Counties.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT WORCESTER COUNTY SHALL REIMBURSE THE CITY OF WORCESTER FOR THE TIME SPENT BY POLICE OFFICERS OF SAID CITY WHILE IN ATTENDANCE AS WITNESSES IN CERTAIN COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The county commissioners and the treasurer of Worcester
- 2 county are hereby authorized and directed to reimburse the
- 3 city of Worcester pro rata for the salary or wages paid to
- 4 police officers of the city of Worcester for the time spent in
- 5 attendance in the various courts within said county as wit-
- 6 nesses.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE

Article I. The Legislative Department.

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in a Senate and House of Representatives, which shall be styled the General Assembly.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of members chosen for terms of four years, one-half of whom shall be chosen in each year.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen for terms of two years, one-half of whom shall be chosen in each year. The number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every five thousand inhabitants.
