AN ACT RELATIVE TO ACADEMIC DEGREES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 General Laws Chapter 71, section 40 is amended by adding
2 the following paragraph: —

3 “For purposes of promotion or salary increases of teachers
4 employed in any public day school in the Commonwealth, the
5 board of education or any school committee shall approve any
6 academic degree or its equivalent that has been granted or
7 issued by a school, college, or university that has been granted
8 a charter by the Commonwealth to issue such academic
9 degree or its equivalent”.
