AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES REQUIRED ON  
PRIMARY NOMINATION PAPERS FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILLOR AND  
FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The third sentence of section 44 of chapter 53 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 260 of the acts of 1964, is here-  
3 by amended by striking out, in lines 5 and 6, the words "one  
4 thousand" and inserting in place thereof the words: — five  
5 hundred.
