

By Mr. Bisbee, a petition of Charles A. Bisbee, Jr., for legislation to provide that the procedure against certain violators of motor vehicle laws be extended to include violations on lands of the University of Massachusetts. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE PROCEDURE AGAINST CERTAIN VIOLATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS BE EXTENDED TO INCLUDE VIOLATIONS ON LANDS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
 2 defeat its purpose which is to facilitate enforcement of the  
 3 motor vehicle laws on lands of the University of Massachusetts,  
 4 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, neces-  
 5 sary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience  
 6 and safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90C of the General Laws,  
 2 as appearing in section 2 of chapter 789 of the acts of 1962,  
 3 is hereby amended by striking out the definition of "Police  
 4 Chief" and inserting in place thereof the following defini-  
 5 tion: —

6 "Police chief", the chief or the head of the organized police  
 7 department of a city or town, the commissioner of public  
 8 safety, the superintendent of the metropolitan district com-  
 9 mission police, the registrar of motor vehicles, the state super-  
 10 intendent of buildings, the chairman of the Massachusetts  
 11 Turnpike Authority, or such person as the trustees of the  
 12 Massachusetts shall appoint as chief of the police officers ap-  
 13 pointed under section thirty-two A of chapter seventy-five.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 90C is hereby  
2 further amended by striking out the definition of "Police  
3 officer," as amended by section 2 of chapter 340 of the acts  
4 of 1963, and inserting in place thereof the following defini-  
5 tion:—

6 "Police officer", any officer, other than an investigator or  
7 examiner of the commercial motor vehicle division of the de-  
8 partment of public utilities, authorized to make arrest or  
9 serve criminal process, any person appointed by the registrar  
10 under section twenty-nine of chapter ninety, and any person  
11 appointed by the trustees of the University of Massachusetts  
12 under section thirty-two A of chapter seventy-five.
