AN ACT REQUIRING FUNERAL DIRECTORS TO FURNISH CERTAIN
FLAGS OR PENNANTS TO VEHICLES IN FUNERAL PROCESSIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14A of chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding the following sentence: — Each registered
3 funeral director who conducts a funeral procession shall fur-
4 nish and affix to each vehicle therein a flag or pennant with
5 the word "Funeral" or other identifying designation imprinted
6 thereon for the purpose of ensuring uninterrupted processions.
