By Mr. McIntyre, a petition of James R. McIntyre for legislation to provide that the use of a motor vehicle without authority shall, in certain cases, be a felony. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT USING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT AUTHORITY SHALL, IN CERTAIN INSTANCES, BE A FELONY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (2) (a) of section 24 of chapter 90 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 230 of the
3 acts of 1937, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the
4 first sentence the following: — or, if a person who uses a
5 motor vehicle without authority knowing that such use is
6 unauthorized, removes such vehicle from the city or town in
7 which it is parked, by imprisonment in the state prison for
8 not more than five years.
