AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN TRAILERS OF CERTAIN WEIGHT TO BE OPERATED ON THE WAYS OF THE COMMONWEALTH WITHOUT A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 19 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the third sentence, as most recently  
3 amended by chapter 553 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following sentence: — Except as provided in  
5 this section, no trailer which with its load weighs more than  
6 five thousand pounds, other than a semi-trailer, a heavy duty  
7 platform trailer, a cable reel trailer, a house trailer, or a trailer  
8 which is an apparatus or other object on wheels not used to  
9 transport other things for delivery, shall be operated or drawn  
10 on any way without a permit so to operate from the depart-  
11 ment of public works.
