AN ACT PROVIDING THAT NO BOND BE REQUIRED FOR THE REMOVAL OF CERTAIN ACTIONS FROM DISTRICT COURTS BY CERTAIN PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 107 of chapter 231 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "corporation", in line 3,
3 as appearing in section 4 of chapter 296 of the acts of 1943,
4 the words: — or of a board, officer or employee thereof repre-
5 sented by the city solicitor, town counsel or other officer hav-
6 ing similar duties.
