AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE HEALTH AND WELFARE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 10 of Chapter 151D of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph to the end  
3 thereto: — The fact of employment of any employee, by any  
4 employer, shall be sufficient cause to bind the employer to  
5 the full payment of the full wage package, including all fringe  
6 benefits, that have been duly negotiated through a master con-  
7 tract, by and between labor and management, within the area  
8 and work jurisdiction. And hereunder, to apply to all work.
