AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ACQUIRE LAND IN THE NORTH END DISTRICT, SO CALLED, OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AND TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN THEREON A SWIMMING POOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct and maintain an outdoor swimming
- 3 pool with appurtenant facilities, including locker rooms,
- 4 showers and other facilities, in the North End district, so
- 5 called, of the city of Boston, the site to be determined by
- 6 the commission. For the purposes of this act, said commission
- 7 may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
