The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE AMOUNT OF NON-CONTRIBUTORY PENSION PAID TO CERTAIN FORMER FIREMEN BE INCREASED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, any permanent member of a fire department who
3 prior to May fourteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, was
4 retired under the provisions of subdivision (b), (c) or (d) of
5 section eighty-one A of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws
6 shall have his annual pension adjusted so as to comply with the
7 provisions of section eighty-one B of said chapter thirty-two,
8 as amended by chapter sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hun-
9 dred and sixty-four.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the affirmative vote of a majority of all the members of
3 the city council in a city having a Plan D or Plan E charter,
4 in a city not having such a charter by vote of the city council,
5 subject to the provisions of the charter of such city; and in
6 a town by a majority vote at a town meeting.
