
By Mr. Hogan, a petition of Katherine C. Kilroy for legislation to authorize her to become a member of the Teachers' Retirement System, and to regulate the retirement allowance to be paid to her. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING KATHERINE C. KILROY OF LYNN TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, AND REGULATING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE TO BE PAID HER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of chapter thirty-two of the
2 General Laws to the contrary, Katherine C. Kilroy of Lynn is
3 hereby declared eligible for membership in the teachers' re-
4 tirement system upon payment of the customary deductions
5 and interest thereon as in the case of late entries into said
6 system. Such deductions shall be based on the salary received
7 by her for service as a regular teacher in the public day
8 schools of the commonwealth up to the month of August, nine-
9 teen hundred and fifty-seven. The interest on said deductions
10 shall be accumulated to said month of August. Upon re-pay-
11 ment to the teachers' retirement board in one sum of the
12 amount withdrawn by her, said Katherine C. Kilroy shall re-
13 ceive, from the date of such payment, a retirement allowance
14 as provided by section five of chapter thirty-two of the Gen-
15 eral Laws at the same annual rate, based on her accumulated
16 deductions, salary and service as such regular teacher, which
17 she would have received had she been a member of the teach-
18 ers' retirement system on August first, nineteen hundred and
19 fifty-seven, which retirement allowance shall be paid only in
20 accordance with the terms of Option (a) of subdivision (2) of
21 section twelve of said chapter thirty-two.
