By Mr. Ames, a petition of John F. Upton for legislation to increase the salary of the chairman of the Boston Finance Commission and establishing a salary for the other members of said commission. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOSTON FINANCE COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY FOR THE OTHER MEMBERS OF SAID COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17 or chapter 486 of the acts of 1909 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last two sentences and inserting
3 in place thereof the following two sentences: — His annual
4 salary shall be seventy-five hundred dollars, which shall be
5 paid in monthly instalments by the city of Boston. Each of the
6 other members shall receive an annual salary of twenty-five
7 hundred dollars, which shall be paid in monthly instalments
8 by the city of Boston.
