AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE FOR CERTAIN EXECUTIVE SECRETARIES OF HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 26S of chapter 121 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the second paragraph, as most re-
3 cently amended by chapter 784 of the acts of 1962, and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 Chapter thirty-one and the rules made thereunder shall not
6 apply to any officer, agent or employee of a housing authority
7 or of the housing board or to any person employed on or in
8 connection with any project of a housing authority; provided,
9 however, that no employee of the state housing board or of any
10 housing authority, who has held his office or position, includ-
11 ing any promotion or reallocation therefrom within the board
12 or authority, for a total period of one year of uninterrupted
13 service shall be involuntarily separated therefrom, except sub-
14 ject to and in accordance with the provisions of sections forty-
15 three and forty-five of said chapter thirty-one to the same ex-
16 tent as if said office or position were classified under said
17 chapter.
