AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A FOURTH ASSISTANT REGISTER OF
PROBATE IN HAMPDEN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out Section 25A as amended by Section 1 of Chapter
3 440 of the Acts of 1956 and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section: —

5 *Section 25A.* Third and fourth assistant registers for cer-
6 tain counties.

7 The judges of probate for the counties of Essex and Norfolk
8 may appoint a third assistant register for their respective
9 counties, and the judges of probate for the counties of
10 Worcester and Hampden may appoint a third and a fourth
11 assistant register of probate for their counties, who shall
12 hold office for three years unless sooner removed by the judges.
13 They shall be subject to the laws relative to assistant registers.
