**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF THE MEMBERS OF  
THE MASSACHUSETTS PARKING AUTHORITY.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section three of chapter six hundred and six of the acts of  
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-eight is hereby amended by strik-  
3 ing out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following sentence: — The Massachusetts Parking Authority  
5 shall consist of three members, two of whom, hereinafter re-  
6 ferred to as the governor's appointees, shall be appointed by  
7 the governor, and the third member shall be such officer of the  
8 city as the mayor of the city shall from time to time designate,  
9 who shall serve ex officio. The chairman of the Authority  
10 designated by the governor as hereinafter provided, shall re-  
11 ceive a salary of five thousand dollars and each of the other  
12 members shall receive fifty dollars for each day of service  
13 actually rendered, not exceeding two thousand five hundred  
14 dollars per year. Said sums referred to heretofore shall be  
15 payable solely from revenues received by said Authority.
