AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF POPULATION FIGURES IN DETERMINING MUNICIPAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT COMPENSATION PLANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 47D of chapter 31 of the General Laws, inserted by
2 section 1 of chapter 402 of the acts of 1941, is hereby amended
3 by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — The director may, with like
5 approval, make rules and regulations providing for the ap-
6 plication and administration of said compensation plan; pro-
7 vided, however, that no such compensation plan shall be based
8 in any way upon the number of military personnel, or their
9 families, who are not registered voters within the particular
10 municipality.
