AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION TO THE GENERAL COURT ON THE CONDITION OF CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 124 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 10 of chapter 770 of the acts of
3 1955, is hereby further amended by adding the following two
4 paragraphs: —

5 Said report shall also include a complete financial report
6 based on the last preceding fiscal year, and shall include all
7 sums appropriated for each correctional institution during said
8 fiscal year including all sums authorized under any capital
9 outlay act. Said report shall also contain all amounts borrowed
10 for construction or major repair in the department, the amount
11 of indebtedness outstanding, and the yearly payments on the
12 principal of such loans and the yearly interest paid on such
13 loans. The report shall also state the total amount allocated
14 to the commissioner, and his staff, and the number of perma-
15 nent positions at each correctional institution.

16 The parole board in submitting its report to the commis-
17 sioner, as provided above, shall include therein a complete
18 financial report for the preceding fiscal year, and shall set
19 forth the number of permanent positions.
