

judgment of the commissioner, and then only during the months of June, July, August, September and October, shall not exceed fifty-two, provided that the total number of such hours in any year shall not exceed an average of forty-eight hours a week for the whole year, excluding Sundays and holidays; and if any child or woman shall be employed or permitted to work in more than one such place, the total number of hours of such employment shall not exceed forty-eight hours in any one week.

**Chap.369** AN ACT EXTENDING TO CERTAIN STUDENTS OF MEDICINE THE PRIVILEGE OF BECOMING REGISTERED AS QUALIFIED PHYSICIANS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, any person who was a resident of the commonwealth for a period of five years prior to July first, nineteen hundred and forty-one, who matriculated at any medical school in the commonwealth prior to said date, and who has since received a degree of doctor of medicine therefrom, shall be eligible to be an applicant for registration as a qualified physician, shall be examined for such registration by the board of registration in medicine, and shall be subject to and have the benefit of all pertinent provisions of law relative to such eligibility and examination.

**Chap.370** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO MAKE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES TO PROPERLY COMMEMORATE THE DEDICATION AND COMMISSIONING OF THE U. S. S. "WORCESTER".

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The city of Worcester may appropriate a sum not exceeding seventy-five hundred dollars for the purpose of providing a suitable gift for the U. S. S. "Worcester" to properly commemorate the dedication and commissioning of the aforesaid ship.

**Chap.371** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF DUKES COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY FOR CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR WORK AT THE COUNTY AIRPORT AND ON HIGHWAY APPROACHES THERETO.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Dukes County may expend, for the purpose of providing runways and parking areas and making necessary repairs at the public airport operated by said county, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars, and, for the construction and
