AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE WORCESTER AND HAMPDEN SENATORIAL DISTRICT TO WORCESTER, HAMPDEN AND HAMPSHIRE SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 57 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 432 of the
3 acts of 1960, is hereby further amended by striking out, in
4 line 2, under the heading "Seventh." , the words "Worcester
5 and Hampden" and inserting in place thereof the words: Wor-
6 cester, Hampden and Hampshire.

1 SECTION 2. Section 3 of said chapter 57, as most recently
2 amended by section 2 of said chapter 432, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the heading "*Worcester and Hamp-*
4 *den*" and inserting in place thereof the words: — *Worcester,*
5 *Hampden and Hampshire.*
