By Mr. Della Russo, a petition of Harry Della Russo for legislation to provide that exemptions from the real estate tax granted to certain veterans and other persons be continued in certain cases. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE EXEMPTIONS FROM THE REAL ESTATE TAX GRANTED TO CERTAIN VETERANS AND OTHER PERSONS BE CONTINUED IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of clause Seventeenth,
2 Twenty-second, Twenty-second A, Twenty-second B, Twenty-
3 second C, Thirty-seventh or Forty-first of section five of chap-
4 ter fifty-nine of the General Laws, any person who was en-
5 titled thereunder to an exemption or abatement on his real
6 estate tax for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-four shall,
7 notwithstanding the fact that the value of his estate may have
8 so increased, due solely to the establishment of a general re-
9 assessment plan in a city or town. as to make him no longer
10 eligible for such exemption or abatement, be entitled to the
11 same amount of real estate tax exemption or abatement for
12 the year nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and for each sub-
13 sequent year; provided, that he is otherwise eligible.
