The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY MAKE CERTAIN ANNUAL PAYMENTS TO THE CITY OF CHELSEA IN LIEU OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts Port Authority shall pay annually to the
2 city of Chelsea on or before November first, in reimbursement
3 for the loss of taxes to said city as the result of the taking
4 of certain taxable property for the building of the Mystic
5 River bridge, an amount equal to the average amount of money
6 actually received in taxes by said city for the years nineteen
7 hundred and forty-four to nineteen hundred and forty-six,
8 inclusive, on the real property so taken.
