AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF STINK BOMBS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding the following section: —

3 *Section 15.* Whoever sells or offers for sale a stink bomb
4 shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more
5 than two hundred dollars. As used in this section the words
6 "stink bomb" shall mean a small bomb that gives off a foul
7 odor on bursting or any compound or device prepared for the
8 primary purpose of generating a foul odor and sold or offered
9 for sale for such purpose.
