AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE TOWN OF BILLERICA OF THE PROVISIONS OF LAW ESTABLISHING MINIMUM ANNUAL COMPENSATION FOR FIRE FIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of any general or
2 special law, the following question shall be placed upon the of-
3 ficial ballot to be used for the election of officers at the annual
4 town meeting to be held in the town of Billerica in the current
5 year: — "Shall the town vote to accept the provisions of sec-
6 tion one hundred and eight F of chapter forty-one of the Gen-
7 eral Laws whereby, if accepted, the minimum annual compen-
8 sation of each fire fighter in the fire department of the town
9 of Billerica shall be not less than five thousand five hundred
10 dollars for the first year of service, six thousand dollars for
11 the second year of service, and six thousand three hundred
12 dollars for the third and each succeeding year of service?" If
13 a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the
14 affirmative, said section shall thereupon become effective in
15 said town.

RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF BOSTON

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AMENDMENT OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF BOSTON

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Conference on the Thirtieth day of February, A. D. 1920.

1. The Charter of the City of Boston, as amended, shall be amended so that the following provisions shall be inserted therein, to-wit:
2. That the City of Boston shall have the right to acquire and hold real estate for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
3. That the City of Boston shall have the right to borrow money for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
4. That the City of Boston shall have the right to contract with any person for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
5. That the City of Boston shall have the right to sue and be sued in its corporate capacity.
6. That the City of Boston shall have the right to acquire and hold real estate for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
7. That the City of Boston shall have the right to borrow money for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
8. That the City of Boston shall have the right to contract with any person for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
9. That the City of Boston shall have the right to sue and be sued in its corporate capacity.
10. That the City of Boston shall have the right to acquire and hold real estate for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
11. That the City of Boston shall have the right to borrow money for the purpose of carrying out its municipal duties.
