AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE AMOUNT OF NON-CONTRIBUTORY PENSION PAID TO CERTAIN FORMER POLICEMEN BE INCREASED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in
2 any city which accepts this act, any member of the police
3 department who prior to March twenty-fifth, nineteen hun-
4 dred and sixty-four, was retired under the provisions of sub-
5 division (b), (c) or (d) of section eighty-three A of chapter
6 thirty-two of the General Laws shall have his annual pension
7 adjusted so as to comply with the provisions of said section
8 eighty-three A, as amended by chapter three hundred and
9 fifty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four.
