AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ASSISTANT CLERKS AT THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COURT OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the third paragraph, added by
- 3 Chapter 778 of the Acts of 1963, the following paragraph: —
- 4 A fifth and sixth assistant clerk with salary payable by the
- 5 county may be appointed, subject to the approval of the county
- 6 commissioners, in the Central District Court of Worcester.
