AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FITCHBURG TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE PROCEEDS OF A BOND ISSUE A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate from the balance remaining from the proceeds of
3 a bond issue dated August 1, 1963, designated as school con-
4 struction "Crocker," and authorized by Council Order #354
5 on May 21, 1963, the sum of twenty-six hundred and forty
6 dollars for the payment of an unpaid bill of New England Seal
7 Coating Co., Inc. for materials furnished and services rendered
8 in hard-topping Whittemore Street in said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Fitchburg.
