RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO DIRECTING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PLYMOUTH COUNTY TO CAUSE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS TO BE PREPARED FOR ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS TO THE COUNTY COURTHOUSE IN THE CITY OF BROCKTON.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representa-
3 tives, the chairman of the county commissioners of Plymouth
4 county, and one person to be appointed by the governor, is
5 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
6 and study of the subject matter of current house document
7 numbered 3415, relative to directing the county commissioners
8 of the county of Plymouth to cause plans and specifications to
9 be prepared for additions and alterations to the Plymouth
10 county courthouse in the city of Brockton.
